

Lawrenceville Borough Council Special Meeting

February 17 at 6pm

Call to Order: Council President Hotelling called to order the Special meeting of the Lawrenceville Borough at 6 Pm

Pledge of Allegiance

Public comment on Agenda items: No public comment

New Business:

- **Limit for Card Spending** – Council President Hotelling stated there needs to be a set limit for the debit card use.

Motion was made by Councilman O'Dell; Seconded by Councilman Wetzel to set the debit card limit at \$500 per day. Roll Call Vote: 6/0 with Councilman Penzone absent. Motion Carried.

- **Sewer & Water Expenses & ongoing upkeep** – Councilman O'Dell stated the expenses for the past week and ongoing concerns:

Sludge needed to be emptied, so B&L Services removed the sludge to provide ample space for anything extra that shall arise.

Purchases a Case of Oil from at Napa, based on recommendation from Jimmie Joe for the equipment. Napa only sells the oil by the case/special order.

Councilman Urbano asked about the SDS sheet for the sewer/water plant

Batteries for the Backhoe were purchased from Tractor Supply because the current batteries were not functioning correctly. It was discussed that the batteries might have been frozen. Councilman Urbano, suggested the purchase of a battery warmer, which would be regular maintenance.

Holland Tractor repair of dry shaft

Lighting needs to be addressed. It was stated this in normal maintenance to purchase new LED ballast.

- **Sewer Plant Spill** – Councilman O’Dell stated DEP was notified about a spill containing chlorine water, it was recorded as 10 gallons. He also discussed with the employees that any spill is to be reported at the time it happens.
