- Lot faces State Street not Franklin Street
- Valuation of his property has decreased and probability of selling his lot is 0%
- Buffer strip- 10 ft. evergreens to keep residential area from being exposed to a quasi public building, a group of 2 or more
- Totally deceiving picture church sent around
