PUBLIC PRESENTATIONS: Greg Cummings from Larsen Design Group stated that the engineering firm was working on a proposal to submit to the Commonwealth of PA to apply for a PA Small Water and Sewer Grant. The proposal will consist of a prior request from 2014 that was denied due to the previously used language within the prior grant proposal that has now been removed. The new grant is asking for CCTV services of the sewer lines, heavy cleaning of sewer mains, repair of grouting joints, lining of Weaver Street sewer lines, manhole cleanout and/or repairs, a new generator for the sewer plant, and labor costs associated with these repairs. The grant request is for the amount of \$201,000 with the borough matching \$35,000 for a total project cost of \$35,000. This grant proposal is being done at no cost to the borough in hopes that Larsen Design Group will be hired to oversee the project if the borough is awarded grant monies. Greg Cummings requested from the council a copy of any letters received from DEP outlining the I&I issues at the sewer plant stating this would really improve the chances of receiving the grant. At 7:15 pm, Mansel O'Dell got up stating, "I have a very important meeting to attend". Jack Young requested of Mansel, "Mansel, do you think you could get copies of the DEP letters for Greg? to which Mansel replied, "I have a very important meeting to attend." Mansel left the meeting at 7:16 pm. A motion was made by Diana McCullough to adopt Resolution #373 and to hire Larsen Design Group to apply for the PA Small Water and Sewer Loan on behalf of the Lawrenceville Borough Authority. Bradley Hackett seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken and the results were as follows: Larry Barnes:-Yes, Marian Russell-No, Bradley Hackett-Yes, Diana McCullough-Yes, and Jack Young-Yes. The motion carried.
