APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Larry Barnes made a Motion to approve the minutes of April 7, 2008, seconded by Ed Lockhart. All members present voted yea.

PUBLIC PRESENTATIONS-

Robert Blake asked about his Demolition application regarding the shed addition on the rear of the main structure at 14 Cowanesque St. The Council reviewed the application. Larry Barnes made a Motion to approve the demolition application for the shed addition on the rear of the main structure, seconded by Gordon Chilson. All members voted yea.

Some comments from residents were as follows: 2 boys from Buffards trailer park were recklessly driving a lawn tractor down the street & through yards. The Code Enforcer and Buffards will be contacted.

Crystal Stage asked the Council about a dumpster for the ball field. The Council will look into the matter.

Tom Rotsell had questions about subdivision lot requirements. The Council asked him to submit his plans to the Borough Office. He may need to apply for a Variance.

Bob Blair from the Tioga County Development Corporation spoke about the County Abatement 5 year program. The Council would need to decide to adopt the program first and each company needs to get Council approval. Current companies can do expansion and modernize under this program. The program is to encourage economic development.

Attorney Jeff Loomis, Attorney for the Water Authority, stated that DCED had rejected the previous Ordinance #232, regarding the \$140,000 loan for improvements to the Municipal Water System. He presented the Council with a new Ordinance #233.

Jack Young made a Motion to Adopt Ordinance #233 approving and authorizing the execution and delivery of a Guaranty agreement between the Lawrenceville Borough Municipal Authority and the Borough of Lawrenceville, seconded by Ed Lockhart. A Roll Call Vote was taken with all members present voting yea.

Attorney Jeff Loomis stated that the enactment of Ordinance #233 automatically rescinds Ordinance #232.

COMMUNICATIONS were reviewed. The Association Dinner will be held on May 15 at Liberty Borough.

TREASURER'S REPORT- Mildred Bliss made a Motion to accept the Treasurer's Report, seconded by Larry Barnes. All members present voted yea.

PAYMENT OF BILLS-Gordon Chilson made a Motion to pay the bills totaling \$ 3,385.88 seconded by Mildred Bliss. All members present voted yea.

Jack Young made a Motion to accept Heysham Paving Co., \$ 2,500 for pothole patching of Downtown Borough Streets (excluding State St), with a project completion date of 60 days, seconded by Larry Barnes. A Roll call vote was taken with all members present voting yea.

Ed Lockhart stated he received information regarding pot hole patching demonstration and suggested we use it at a later date.

Street Sweeping-Jack Young made a Motion to spend \$ 1,000 on street sweeping and have it done soon, by the same company as last year, seconded by Gordon Chilson. All members present voted yea.
