BOROUGH OF LAWRENCEVILLE SPECIAL MEETING May 7, 2013

Attorney Chris Lantz called the Special Meeting with the Planning Commission and Council Members to order at 2:00 PM. The purpose of this meeting is to discuss the comprehensive plan/zoning map.

Attorney Chris Lantz presented a draft template of a comprehensive plan and the types of data that needs to be put into it. The beginning provisions of the zoning ordinance are setting forth the zones. It was suggested that the Planning Commission work on updating the comprehensive plan. The Planning Commission would then make a recommendation to the Borough Council of what districts and what permitted uses, exceptions, and conditional uses are allowed in what areas. The Borough Council has the final decision.

County Planner, Jim Weaver is available to answer any questions. Also Charlie Andrews and Bud (George) Brooks of Covington are familiar with Comprehensive plans. The municipal planning code requires that mineral extraction, adult entertainment be allowed somewhere in the Borough. There was a discussion regarding the zoning map and the comprehensive plan.

It was recommended we start new instead of amending our 1974 comprehensive plan. The Tioga County Comprehensive Plan (2005) includes Lawrenceville Borough. It is available on-line for viewing. The Planning Commission will meet to review the information to draft a comprehensive plan. Once a new comprehensive plan has been approved by the Council, a public hearing is required to adopt the comprehensive plan and zoning ordinance.
